

ATT National 2011 picks

The players picked here may or may not be the best players in the world. The players chosen either finished in the top 20s or better in recent events or finished in the top 20 at the ATT National tournament over the past 5 years.

Webb Simpson – Simpson is coming off 3 solid finishes and followed up his 14th place finish at the US Open with a 13th place finish at the Travelers last week.

Nick Watney – Watney finished 13th last week at the Travelers after missing the cut at the US Open. He also finished 7th last year at the ATT National tournament.

Bo Van Pelt – A “hot” player with top 15 place finishes in his last 3 starts. Van Pelt finished 11th last year at the ATT National tournament

Ryan Moore – Moore finished 2nd last week and 2nd last year at ATT National.

Bill Haas – Haas is a trending type player with 23rd place finish in his last start and a 45th place finish in the start prior. He didn't play at ATT National last year, but could contend this week.

Justin Rose – Rose won last year. However, he's also missed 3 cuts in a row coming into this year's event. Last year, he had a win and a top 10 coming into the ATT National.

John Merrick – Merrick had a 9th place finish at the Traveler's last week and an 11th in his start prior to the Traveler's. He's playing well and also finished 16th at ATT National last year.

Carl Pettersson – Pettersson has a top 10 finish followed by a top 25 finish coming into this tournament. He also finished in the top 10 at ATT National last year.

Bryce Molder – Molder finished in the top 25 last year and had a 6th place finish last week.

Charles Howell III – Howell has 2 top 25 finishes followed by a 3rd place finish in his last 3 starts. He's a somewhat “hot” player.
