The players picked here may or may not be the best players in the world. The players chosen either finished in the top 20s or better in recent events or finished in the top 20 at the Justin Timberlake event over the past few years.

Martin Laird – Laird finished 2nd last year and won it the year before. He finished 12th in his last start and 74th the one prior which indicates he's on a good trend.

Nick Watney — Watney hasn't exactly lit it up over the past couple of starts, but he's one of the highest ranked players in the field, the Fedex Cup pressure is off and he's seems to be comfortable with the course having finished in the top 10 last year.

Ryan Moore — Moore has posted top 20 finishes in his previous 2 events played and has done better each year at the Timberlake event.

Jonathan Byrd — Byrd won here last year and has a positive trend going on his recent finishes.

Chez Reavie — Reavie didn't do so well last week at the Tour Championship (26th place), but perhaps he can get back the top 10 form he had going into that event this week.

Cameron Tringale – Tringale is on a positive trend and finished 11th in his only start at the Timberlake event last year.

John Mallinger — Mallinger has been lighting it up on the Nationwide Tour with 4 consecutive top 10 finishes, if he can keep it going, he's a great chance for a win.

Jason Bohn – Bohn finished 14th in his only start at the Timberlake event in 2009, and he's one of those players on a positive trend.

George McNeill – McNeill has finished in the top 15 in each of his 4 previous starts at the Timberlake/Frys.com Shriner's, which could indicate he likes playing in Las Vegas.

Carl Pettersson — Pettersson in on a positive trend and is one of those players who can win at any time if he is on his game.
