Rory McIlroy — McIlroy has 3 top 10s in his last 5 events, including a win at the PGA.

Bud Cauley — Cauley has 4 top 10s in his last 5 starts.

Luke Donald — Donald has finished in the top 5 for the last 2 years at the Deutsche Bank, he's also finished in the top 10 in 3 of his last 4 events played.

Steve Stricker — Stricker has won this event and finished in the top 10 in 3 of the last 5 years played at the Deutsche Bank.

Webb Simpson – Simpson is the defending champion.

Jason Dufner — Dufner is on a trend, taking a week off last week probably will help rather than hurt his game.

Jim Furyk — Furyk hasn't exactly set the world on fire lately, but it's hard to argue against his 3 top 10s at this event over the past 4 years played here.
