The Mayakoba picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site.

Spencer Levin — Levin was a pick last week but finished 52nd. Against a much weaker field and an event he finished 2nd at last year, he looks like a solid pick for this week.

Cameron Beckman — Beckman hasn't exactly lit it up lately, however, he did win this event in '10 and has finished in the top 15 in 4 of the last 5 years, seems the course may suit his game.

Brian Gay – Another previous winner and he's on a bit of a trend coming into this event.

Johnson Wagner — Wagner won here last year and has a win already earlier this year and he's on a trend and he's had a second place finish this year as well. He may be the best pick out there this week.

Jarrod Lyle – Lyle has 3 top 10 finishes here over his 3 starts in this event. And he finished 4th last week, he's on a roll.

Heath Slocum – Slocum has a couple decent finishes at this event and has done mediocre over his past couple of starts this year, a bit of a long shot, but he's one of the bigger name players in the field, if you can think of Slocum as a bigger name player...

Peter Lonard – Lonard has a couple of top 10s and a 15th place finish in his last 3 starts. Perhaps he can keep the good play going and get a win. He also has 2 top 10 finishes at Mayakoba, although they were in '07 and '08.

Brian Baird — Baird has 3 top 10s in the last 3 years at Mayakoba, maybe this will be his first PGATour victory. He's on a trend too.

Charles Howell III – Howell is one of the bigger name players here, along with Slocum.

John Huh – Huh is on a backwards trend, but he could turn it around at Mayakoba.
