The PGA Championship picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Tiger Woods – Woods is the favorite at majors, always.

Dustin Johnson — Johnson has a couple of top 10 finishes in the PGA over the past few years and he's from the area, he should be familiar with the course.

Keegan Bradley — Bradley is the defending champion and he won last week at WGC Bridgestone, so he's playing well.

Bubba Watson — Watson has finished inside the top 25 in his last 3 events played including a 2nd place finish.

Jason Dufner — Dufner has top 10 finishes in 4 of his last 5 events played and 2 top 5 finishes at the PGA in the last 2 years.

Matt Kuchar — Kuchar has top 10 finishes in 3 of his last 4 events played and back to back top 20 finishes at the PGA.

Luke Donald — Donald is the number 1 ranked player in the world and comes into the PGA with back to back top 10 finishes in his last 2 events played.

Graeme McDowell – McDowell has top 25 finishes in his last 5 events played.

Adam Scott — Scott has 2 top 5 finishes in his last 3 events played and a 7th place finish at last year's PGA.

Steve Stricker – Stricker is playing solid over his last 5 events, no finishes outside top 23. Stricker also has back to back finishes inside the top 20 at the PGA.
