The Reno Tahoe Open picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Seung-Yul Noh — Noh is on a trend and has been in the top 20 in 4 of his last 5 events played.

Padraig Harrington – Harrington has 4 top 20 finishes in the last 5 weeks.

Josh Teater — Teater has back to back top 10 finishes coming into this event and he finished 10th at the Reno Tahoe last year.

Chris Kirk — Kirk has back to back top 10 finishes also and is on a trend coming into Reno Tahoe.

J.B. Holmes – Holmes is on a trend.

Pat Perez – Perez is another player fairly high up on the birdie average ranking and scoring average as well, plus he finished 2nd at this event last year.

Troy Matteson – Matteson is on a trend and he's 2 top 10 finishes in his last 3 events played.

John Merrick — Merrick is on a trend and has finished in the top 10 at Reno Tahoe in 3 of his last 4 times played.

Billy Hurley III — Hurley has been up and down lately, top 10s every other week, with missed cuts in between. This is the week after a missed cut.

John Rollins — Rollins has 2 top 5 finishes at the Reno Tahoe in his last 3 times played, including a win. However, Rollins has also missed 2 cuts in a row leading into this week.
