

The Open Championship Picks 2012

The Open Championship picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Tiger Woods – If Tiger is in the field, he should be considered as a pick, always.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson is a beast.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has played well in his only 2 Open appearances and he's on a slight trend.

Martin Kaymer – Kaymer is on a trend, he's back to back top 15 finishes at the Open Championship and he's a major winner.

Charl Schwartzel – Schwartzel has top 20 finishes in 4 of his last 5 starts. And, he's back to back top 20 finishes at the Open Championship.

Retief Goosen – Goosen is on a trend and finished in the top 10 in 2 of 3 Opens he most recently played in.

Lee Westwood – Westwood has a win and a top 10 finish in 2 of his last 3 starts coming into the Open Championship and he's 2 top 10 finishes in his last 5 starts at the Open.

Jason Dufner – Dufner has 2 wins and 2 top 5 finishes in his last 5 events played. He's missed the last 2 cuts at the Open however, he seems to have figured out just how to golf his ball which should make him a contender at this year's Open Championship.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy is on a trend and he's 2 top 10 finishes in his last 3 starts.

Graeme McDowell – McDowell has back to back top 20 finishes coming into the Open Championship and he's won a major before.
