Tiger Woods – Woods hasn't exactly lit it up over the past 2 events played (40th and cut), but Woods won The Players before and he does have a win this year.

Phil Mickelson — Mickelson won The Players in '07 but since then hasn't placed inside the top 17. However, Mickelson has 2 top 5 finishes in his previous tourneys played.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has finished in the top 5 in 4 of his last 5 starts coming into The Players. He's playing well and the 2 missed cuts at The Players shouldn't mean too much.

Lee Westwood – Westwood is playing solid over his past 3 tournaments played including a win in Asia. His only start at The Players over the past 5 years was a 4th place finish.

Hunter Mahan – Mahan has improved his finish in each successive year played at The Players.

Luke Donald – Donald finished 4th at The Players last year and finished 3rd in his last tourney played coming into this event.

Adam Scott – Scott has 3 top 15 finishes in a row coming into The Players and he's a previous winner at The Players.

Sergio Garcia — Garcia has been playing decent this year and seems to elevate his game at this course.

Ben Crane — Crane is on a bit of a trend and has 3 years running in the top 10 at The Players ('08, '09, '10).
