

## Travelers Picks 2012

**Webb Simpson** – Simpson won the US Open last week, if he doesn't suffer a letdown, then he should be in contention or possibly win again.

**Bubba Watson** – Watson has won the Travelers before and this course should play easier than the US Open course where he missed the cut last week, which seems to be to his liking.

**Fredrik Jacobson** – Jacobson won the Travelers last year after finishing 14<sup>th</sup> at the US Open the week prior. Last week at the US Open he finished 15<sup>th</sup>, perhaps he could repeat his winning performance at the Travelers this year as well.

**Ryan Moore** – Moore seems to play well at the Travelers, 2 top 10s and a 13<sup>th</sup> place finish over the past 3 years he's played the Travelers.

**Bo Van Pelt** – Van Pelt was playing well prior to the US Open but finished 59<sup>th</sup> there. Perhaps he can put together another decent streak starting at the Travelers.

**Padraig Harrington** – Harrington finished 4<sup>th</sup> last week at the US Open and has a top 5 finish at the Travelers, plus he's on a bit of a trend now, missed cut followed by 13<sup>th</sup> place finish then 4<sup>th</sup>.

**Hunter Mahan** – Mahan is another former winner of the Travelers and he can make birdies in bunches when he's on.

**Ian Poulter** – Poulter played okay at the US Open although his 41<sup>st</sup> place finish doesn't reflect it, he shot 73, 73 on the weekend. Last year at the Travelers, he finished 24<sup>th</sup>.

**Matt Kuchar** – Kuchar has back to back top 30 finishes since winning the Player's last month. Plus Kuchar is playing well overall this year.
