

WGC Bridgestone Picks 2012

The WGC Bridgestone picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Tiger Woods – Woods has won here many times. And he's won 2 of his last 5 starts this year.

Steve Stricker – Stricker has top 25 finishes in 4 of his last 5 starts coming into this event, and 2 top 10s in his last 3 starts at the Bridgestone.

Adam Scott – Scott is the defending champion of the Bridgestone and he's 2 top 5 finishes in his last 2 starts coming into the event.

Jason Day – Day is on a trend leading into Bridgestone and is on a trend at the event itself over the past 2 years played.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler is on a trend as well, both at the event and leading into it.

Francesco Molinari – Molinari has top 10s in 3 of his last 4 starts coming into the Bridgestone and he finished 15th at the Bridgestone last year.

Bubba Watson – Watson has 2 top 25 finishes at Bridgestone.

Ian Poulter – Poulter has back to back top 10 finishes coming into this event.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson is on a trend.

Hunter Mahan – Mahan has top 20 finishes in 3 of his last 4 events played and he's finished in the top 10 in 3 of the last 4 years at Bridgestone, including a win.
