

Wells Fargo Picks 2012

Wells Fargo picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, etc.

Tiger Woods – Despite his 40th place finish in his previous start at Augusta earlier this year, Woods won this event in the past and he has posted a win this year.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson has 2 top 5 finishes in a row coming into the Wells tourney and he's posted top 10 finishes the past 3 years at the Wells Fargo event.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has finished in the top 5 in 4 of his last 5 starts this year. He won this event 2 years ago as well.

Hunter Mahan – Mahan has been hot over the past few weeks played and has played well over the past couple years at this event.

Lee Westwood – Westwood has been playing solid over his past 2 tournaments played including a win in Asia. He doesn't have the best finishes at Wells, but he didn't seem as good a player then as he is now.

Jim Furyk – Furyk comes into the tourney playing well and has won this event in the past, over the past 4 years he's 2 top 10s, and 11th and a 24th place finish.

Webb Simpson – Simpson is on a bit of a trend, he should do well at this event, plus he posted a top 25 last year at Wells.

Jonathan Byrd – Byrd lost in a playoff to Lucas Glover last year at this event, he's on a bit of a trend over his past 2 events played coming into this tourney.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler is on trend, posted a top 10 in his last event played and has a 16th place finish last year at Wells and a 6th place finish the year before (his first tourney at Quail Hollow).
