

## ATT National Picks 2013

ATT National picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

**Jason Day** – Day finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in his last start at the US Open, and he's finished inside the top 10 in each of his last 2 starts at ATT National.

**Adam Scott** – Scott has 2 top 20 finishes in his last 3 starts coming into the event, however, he's finished 3<sup>rd</sup> at ATT National over the past 2 years.

**Ryan Palmer** – Palmer was on a trend prior to missing the cut in his last start prior to ATT National. Palmer finished 15<sup>th</sup> last year at this event.

**Rickie Fowler** – Fowler has back to back top 15 finishes coming into the event and he finished 13<sup>th</sup> in his most recent start at ATT National (2011).

**Martin Laird** – Laird is on a trend coming into this tourney and finished 11<sup>th</sup> last year.

**Graham DeLaet** – DeLaet has top 25 finishes in his last 4 events played. His best finish at ATT National in 2 starts over the past 5 years is 33<sup>rd</sup> in 2010.

**Billy Horschel** – Horschel has back to back top 10 finishes coming into the ATT National, however, he missed the cut in his last 2 attempts at this event (2011 and 2009).

**Jeff Overton** – Overton is on a slight trend with a 75<sup>th</sup> place finish in his last event played, however, Overton has 3 top 10 finishes over the past 5 years at the ATT National tourney.

**Nick Watney** – Watney has missed the cut 3 times in a row in his last 3 tournaments played. However, Watney also has finished inside the top 10 for 3 years in a row at ATT National, including a win in 2011.

**Chris Stroud** – Stroud comes into the tournament with 2 top 10 in his last 3 events played. Stroud also finished 6<sup>th</sup> at ATT National in 2011.
