

Barclay's Picks 2013

The Barclay's picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Tiger Woods – Woods is the favorite, per usual.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 2 top 10s in his last 3 events played. Johnson finished top 10 the past 3 years at Barclay's including a win in 2011. 15th place finish in 2009 at Liberty Nat'l.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson has 5 top 10 finishes in a row coming into the Barclay's.

Zach Johnson – Johnson has 5 top 10 finishes in a row, as well, coming into the Barclay's.

Webb Simpson – Simpson is on a trend and he finished 8th at this event in 2009.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson has 2 wins in his last 4 events played, however, he doesn't have the best Barclay's track record, best finish is 19th in 2008, and 52nd in 2009 at Liberty Nat'l.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy is on a trend. He could light it up and win by 5 shots or miss the cut, just a bit unpredictable this season.

Adam Scott – Scott is also on a slight trend to go along with 2 top 10 finishes in his last 3 events played coming into this tourney.

Jason Day – Day is another player on a trend and he finished 12th in 2009 at the Barclay's at Liberty Nat'l.

Bill Haas – Haas is on a slight trend and he has 2 top 10 finishes in his last 5 events played.
