Tiger Woods – Woods is the favorite, per usual.

Phil Mickelson – Phil has 3 top 10s in his last 5 events played, including 2 wins. Phil won this event in 2007 and he finished 4th last year.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy is the defending champion and he has 2 top 20 finishes coming into the Deutsche Bank tourney.

Webb Simpson – Simpson has back to back top 15 finishes in his 2 most recent events played and he won this event in 2011, he finished 18th last year.

Adam Scott – Scott has 3 top 10s in his last 4 events played, including a win last week. Scott also has 3 consecutive top 10 finishes at this event over the past 3 years.

Steve Stricker – Stricker has 4 consecutive top 15 finishes coming into this event and he's finished inside the top 15 in 3 of the last 4 years at the Deutsche Bank, including a win in 2009.

Ryan Moore – Moore is on a trend and he's finished 10th at this event in 2011 and 2012.

Jim Furyk — Furyk has 4 top 10 finishes in a row coming into the Deutsche Bank and he's 3 top 10 finishes at Deutsche Bank over the past 5 years.

Zach Johnson – Johnson has 5 top 10 finishes in a row coming into this tourney.

Henrik Stenson – Although Stenson finished 43rd last week, he had 4 top 3s in a row prior to last week.
