

Farmers Picks 2013

Farmers picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker is the defending champion and he has 2 top 5 finishes in his last 5 starts and each of his 5 most recent finishes have been top 25s.

Bubba Watson – Watson won this event 2 years ago and he comes to the event having 3 consecutive top 10 finishes.

Tiger Woods – Woods last won this event in 2008 and he missed the cut in his last event played. However, prior to his missed cut last week, he finished 4th three times and 8th the other.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has back to back top 10 finishes coming into this event and he has 3 top 20 finishes at the Farmers in his last 3 starts here.

Nick Watney – Watney won the Farmers in 2009 and followed up with 2 top 10 finishes in 2010 and 2011. Watney also has finished in the top 20 in the last 5 events he's played, including a win.

Nicolas Colsaerts – Colsaerts comes into the Farmers with 3 top 15 finishes in a row, including a 9th place finish in his first event of 2013.

Scott Piercy – Piercy has improved his placing at the Farmers in each of his 2 starts here. Piercy also has finished in the top 15 in each of his last 5 starts.

Hunter Mahan – Mahan finished 6th in each of his last 2 starts at the Farmers. Mahan comes into the event with back to back top 30 finishes.

Keegan Bradley – Bradley finished 4th at the Hyundai and 49th at the Sony to start this year, but in the only 2 times he's played the Farmers, he's finished 25th and 22nd.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson has 2 top 10 finishes at the Farmers over the past 5 years, he also has 2 second place finishes in his last 5 events played coming into the Farmers.
