

## Frys.com Picks 2013

Frys.com picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

**Hideki Matsuyama** – Matsuyama should be buoyed by both his play at the President's Cup and a win in his 2<sup>nd</sup> most recent event played. Matsuyama hasn't finished outside the top 20 in his last 4 starts.

**John Peterson** – Peterson has 5 top 5 finishes in a row coming into this event.

**Gary Woodland** – Woodland finished 9<sup>th</sup> last year at the Frys and he's finished inside the top 25 in his last 2 events – he also has a win already this year.

**Billy Horschel** – Horschel is on a 3 event trend, he finished 7<sup>th</sup> at the Tour Championship and he had a top 10 at the Frys in 2011.

**Ryo Ishikawa** – Ishikawa has 3 top 10 finishes in a row coming into the Frys.com tourney.

**Russell Knox** – Knox is on a slight trend and he finished inside the top 10 at the Frys.com last year.

**Jimmy Walker** – Walker is another player on a trend and he finished 4<sup>th</sup> last year at the Frys.com. The question is can he or will he get a win...

**Sean O'Hair** – O'Hair is on a trend coming into the Frys.com and last time he played his event he finished in the top 20. If his game is starting to come around again, he could have a big year.

**Patrick Reed** – Reed is on a slight trend coming into the event, he has a win this year and he's on a trend at this event itself (75<sup>th</sup> in 2011, 11<sup>th</sup> last year).

**Rory Sabbatini** – Sabbatini has 2 top 10s in his last 5 events played, he is also on a trend, but he hasn't exactly lit it up at this tourney.
