

Greenbrier Picks 2013

Greenbrier picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Bubba Watson – Watson is on a trend and coming off a 4th place finish in his previous start. It's his first start at Greenbrier, but he seems to do well on these random TPC courses, ala Zurich and Travelers, he's also 3rd on Tour in birdie average. If Appleby can shoot a 59 here...

Webb Simpson – Simpson is also on a trend with a 5th place finish in his most recent event played and he has back to back top 10 finishes at Greenbrier (last year and 2011).

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson finished 2nd in his last 2 starts coming into this event. However, he's missed the cut 2 years straight at Greenbrier. Mickelson is 1st in birdie average on Tour.

Billy Horschel – Horschel has 2 top 10 finishes in his last 3 events played. He finished 66th at Greenbrier in 2011 and 33rd last year. Improving each year and he's 2nd on Tour in birdie average.

Roberto Castro – Castro finished 2nd at ATT National last week and he finished 7th at Greenbrier last year in his first start at the event.

Luke Guthrie – Guthrie is on a trend and finished 21st last week at ATT National. He seems to be another player who likes these TPC courses.

Brendan Steele – Steele has back to back top 20 finishes coming into the Greenbrier. He's not the model of consistency, but perhaps he's found something to get him another win.

David Hearn – Hearn finished in the top 25 in 3 of his last 4 events played, and he finished 18th in 2011 and 12th last year at the Greenbrier. Hearn is 30th in birdie average.

Kevin Chappell – Chappell is on a slight trend coming into the Greenbrier and he finished 17th last year after missing the cut in 2011.

Scott Piercy – Piercy has 2 top 20 finishes at the Greenbrier and 2 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 starts coming into this event. Piercy is 21st in birdie average.
