

Harbour Town Picks 2013

Harbour Town picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Jim Furyk – Furyk won here in 2010, he finished 8th last year, 4th in 2008 and has posted 2 top 10s in his last 4 events played.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar is on a trend with a top 10 finish at Augusta last week and he's on a trend.

Aaron Baddeley – Baddeley is another player on a trend and he's had success here in the past – a few top 10s and a win in 2006. If there was 1 tournament per year he might win, this would be it.

Boo Weekley – Weekley is similar to Baddeley, he's on a trend and he won back to back here in 2007 and 2008. Weekley also had a top 10 at Harbour Town last year.

Ernie Els – Els has back to back top 15 finishes coming into Harbour Town.

Luke Donald – Donald seems to be a bit of a horse for a course here posting consecutive top 5 finishes in 3 of the last 4 years played. He's also on a slight trend coming into the event.

Ben Crane – Crane finished 6th last time he played at Harbour Town in 2011. Crane comes into the event on a trend.

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker is close to being the hottest player on the planet, if he can keep it up, he should win. Just wonder if there may be a bit of a letdown from the Masters in not winning it.

Jason Day – Day is playing well, on a trend and finished 3rd at the Masters last week. Day also finished 9th at Harbour Town in 2011 – the last time he played at this event.

Mark Wilson – Wilson is on a trend and has back to back top 25 finishes at Harbour Town in the last 2 years.
