Pebble Beach picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson is the defending champion here and he won last week.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson won at Pebble Beach in 2009 and 2010.

Nick Watney – Watney finished 43rd last week, but was in the top 15 in his 3 prior starts.

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker finished 2nd in back to back weeks coming into this event.

Robert Garrigus – Garrigus finished in the top 20 at Pebble Beach last year and he's posted top 20 finishes in each of his 3 previous starts coming into this tourney.

Hunter Mahan – Mahan finished 2nd at Pebble Beach in 2011 and last year was 15th. Mahan finished 16th last week and 15th in the week prior.

Padraig Harrington — Harrington in on a trend and finished in the top 10 last week and also finished in the top 10 last year at Pebble Beach.

Jim Furyk – Furyk doesn't have the best record at this event, however, if he starts this season like he finished last season, then he should be a good pick.

Ryan Palmer — Palmer has back to back top 10 finishes coming into this tourney and he's improved his finish at each of his last 2 tourneys at Pebble Beach.

Lee Westwood — Although Westwood hasn't played here lately, he's the 8th ranked player in the world and has top 10 finishes in 3 of his last 5 starts.
