

## WGC Doral Picks 2013

WGC Doral picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

**Tiger Woods** – Woods may not be lighting it up so far, but he can win at anytime, anywhere.

**Hunter Mahan** – Mahan hasn't finished outside the top 20 in his last 5 starts this year and he finished 9<sup>th</sup> in 2011 at the WGC Doral.

**Matt Kuchar** – Kuchar is coming off a win at the Match play championship, he's had 2 other top 10 finishes this year and he has 3 top 10 finishes at the WGC Doral over the past 3 years.

**Charl Schwartzel** – Schwartzel is on a roll this year, in 4 events played he's 3 top 10s, but also a first round loss in the Match play. Schwartzel finished 4<sup>th</sup> at Doral last year and was 2<sup>nd</sup> in 2010.

**Justin Rose** – Rose is the defending champion at Doral and he has 2 top 10s in his only 4 events played this season.

**Bubba Watson** – Watson finished 9<sup>th</sup> at the Match play, after missing the cut in his previous start this season, he also has a 4<sup>th</sup> place finish and a 15<sup>th</sup>. Watson finished 2<sup>nd</sup> at the WGC Doral last year.

**Adam Scott** – Scott has one top 10 out of 2 events played this year, the other was a first round loss in the Match play. Scott has 2 top 10 finishes in the last 5 years played at WGC Doral.

**Keegan Bradley** – Bradley finished 4<sup>th</sup> at the Honda last week which puts him on a trend of better finishes after a first round loss in the Match play. Bradley also finished 8<sup>th</sup> at WGC Doral last year – his first time playing at the event.

**Webb Simpson** – Simpson has 2 top 10 finishes in a row coming into WGC Doral, however, he finished 35<sup>th</sup> last year at the event.

**Steve Stricker** – Stricker has played 2x this year and finished 2<sup>nd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>. Over his last 5 starts at WGC Doral, he hasn't finished outside the top 18 and has 2 top 10 finishes as well.
