

Wells Fargo Picks 2013

Wells Fargo picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy won the event in 2010, he was 2nd last year and the course is going to be a major venue and it's wet here this week.

Bubba Watson – Watson is on a trend. Just keep waiting for these top 20 finishes to become top 10 finishes or maybe a win.

Lee Westwood – Westwood has back to back top 10 finishes coming into this tourney and he finished 5th here last year.

Webb Simpson – After missing the cut in his first 2 tries at this event, he finished 21st in 2011 and 4th last year. Plus, Simpson is coming off a 2nd place finish at the Heritage 2 weeks ago.

Nick Watney – Watney finished 13th and then 15th (Masters and Zurich respectively). He finished 8th at Wells last year.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson finished in the top 10 at Wells in 3 of the last 4 years played. Plus, he can still pretty much win at any given event.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler is the defending champion and he's trending. Also, in 3 starts at Wells, his worst finish is 16th.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia has 3 top 10 finishes in his last 5 events played. But, his best finish at Wells over the past 3 times played here is 28th.

Angel Cabrera – Cabrera finished 2nd at the Masters and followed it up with a win in South America, so he's relatively hot coming into this event. His best finish is 3rd in 2010.

Padraig Harrington – Harrington finished in the top 10 in 2 of his last 3 events played coming into this tourney. Harrington also finished in the top 10 at this event in his last 2 times played here.
