

US Open Picks 2014

US Open picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy finished 15th in his most recent event played, the 4 prior were top 10s, including a win. McIlroy won the US Open in 2011 and finished 10th 2009.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson is on a trend and has back to back top 10 finishes coming into this tourney. Stenson finished in the top 30 at the US Open in 4 of the last 5 years.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson is on a trend and he has 3 top 5 finishes at the US Open over the past 5 years.

Steve Stricker – Stricker also is on a trend and he's 3 straight years of top 20 finishes at the US Open coming into this week.

Ian Poulter – Poulter has 2 top 10 finishes in his 5 most recent events played, he's on a trend and he finished 21st last year at the US Open.

Charl Schwartzel – Schwartzel has 3 top 15 finishes over his last 5 events played, he's also on a trend and he's 3 top 20 finishes over the past 4 years at the US Open.

Jason Dufner – Dufner finished 4th at the US Open the past 2 years in a row. Dufner also has a 19th place finish in his most recent event played and a 2nd the event prior.

Lee Westwood – Westwood finished in the top 25 every year for the past 5 years at the US Open. Westwood has 2 top 10 finishes in his 5 most recent events played, including a win.

Justin Rose – Rose is the defending US Open Champion and he has 3 top 10 finishes in his 5 most recent events played.

Graeme McDowell – McDowell has 4 top 20 finishes at the US Open over the past 5 years played, including a win in 2010. McDowell is also on a trend coming into this event.
