**Rory McIlroy** — McIlroy has 3 wins in a row, followed by a 22<sup>nd</sup> finish at Barclays last week. McIlroy won the Deutsche Bank 2 years ago.

**Rickie Fowler** — Fowler has 5 top 10 finishes in a row in his 5 most recent events played. Fowler is one of the hottest players on tour coming into this event.

**Henrik Stenson** — Stenson has 2 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he is the defending Deutsche Bank champion.

**Jason Day** – Day is on a trend with a 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish at Barclays last week. Day finished 2<sup>nd</sup> at Deutsche Bank in 2010 and 3<sup>rd</sup> in 2011. Apparently he's recovered from injury.

**Jim Furyk** – Furyk, like Fowler has 5 top 10 finishes in a row in his 5 most recent events played and is one of the hottest players on tour coming into this event. Furyk also has 2 top 10 finishes at Deutsche Bank in 2009 and 2011.

**Adam Scott** – Scott has 5 straight top 15 finishes in his 5 most recent events played. Scott also has 3 top 10 finishes at this event over the past 4 years.

**Matt Kuchar** – Kuchar has 2 top 10 finishes in his 3 most recent events played. Kuchar finished 4<sup>th</sup> at Deutsche Bank last year.

**Phil Mickelson** – Mickelson finished inside the top 25 in 4 of his 5 most recent events played and he has 2 top 10 finishes at this event over the past 3 years..
