

Harbour Town Picks 2014

Harbour Town picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Jim Furyk – Furyk has 3 top 10s in his most recent 3 events played, including a 14th place finish at the Masters last week. Furyk also won this event in 2010.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar has 3 top 10 finishes in a row coming into Harbour Town. However, Kuchar's best finish at Harbour Town in the last 5 years is 14th in 2010.

Graeme McDowell – McDowell is the defending champion and he had 2 top 10 finishes in a row prior to his missed cut at the Masters last week.

Zach Johnson – Johnson was on a trend prior to missing the cut last week at the Masters. Johnson tied for 2nd at Harbour Town in 2012, his best finish in the past 5 years at this event.

Luke Donald – Donald has 4 top 3 finishes over the past 5 years at Harbour Town. Although Donald missed the cut last week at the Masters, he posted 2 top 10 finishes in his 4 events prior.

Kevin Na – Na has 4 top 15 finishes in his 5 most recent events played including a 2nd and a 4th. Na also finished 8th at Harbour Town in 2012 and 9th in 2011.

Charley Hoffman – Hoffman has back to back top 10 finishes at Harbour Town in the last 2 years. Hoffman made the cut in his 4 most recent events played, including 2 top 15s.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 2 top 10s in his most recent 3 events played, including 2nd at the Masters last week. Spieth finished 9th last year at Harbour Town, his first start at this event.

Harris English – English was on a trend prior to missing the cut at the Masters last week. He has 2 top 15 finishes in his 5 most recent events played and he finished 8th at this event in 2012.

Chris Stroud – Stroud has 4 top 20 finishes in his 5 most recent events played and he finished 6th at Harbour Town last year.
