

Honda Picks 2014

Honda picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Tiger Woods – Woods is on a trend and has 2 top 10s in his last 5 starts. He's also the number 1 ranked player in the world.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy won this event 2 years ago and he's 3 top 10s in his most recent 5 events played, including a win.

Adam Scott – Scott may not have the best record at Honda, but he has not finished outside the top 10 in 6 starts coming into this event (including 2 wins).

Charl Schwartzel – Schwartzel has 2 top 10s in his most recent 5 starts and he's finished inside the top 10 in the last 2 consecutive years at Honda and finished 14th in 2011.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler is on a trend coming off a 3rd place finish at the Match Play last week. Fowler finished 13th at the Honda last year and 7th in 2012.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 starts coming into this event, including 2 wins. Garcia hasn't played Honda since 2010 (50th) and 13th in 2009.

Graeme McDowell – McDowell has 3 consecutive top 10 finishes coming into the Honda and he has 3 consecutive top 10 finishes at this tourney in the last 3 years.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson is on a trend and can win pretty much any time he tees it up, however, Mickelson hasn't played this event since 2002.

Peter Hanson – Hanson is on a trend and he finished 13th at the Honda last year.

Zach Johnson – Johnson had 4 consecutive top 10 finishes, including 2 wins, before losing in the first round last week at the Match Play. Johnson last played this event in 2008, he finished 30th.
