Pebble Beach picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson is on a bit of a trend and he won this event back to back in 2009 and 2010.

Jason Day – Day finished in the top 10 in his last 4 events played, including a win. Day finished 6^{th} at Pebble Beach last year.

Phil Mickelson — Mickelson won this event in 2012. However, Mickelson finished 42nd last week and wd'd the week prior with back issues.

Hunter Mahan – Mahan is on a trend and he's finished inside the top 20 over the past 3 years at Pebble Beach, including 2nd in 2011..

Spencer Levin – Levin is another player on a trend, and he has 2 top 10 finishes at Pebble Beach in the last 2 years he played (9th 2012, 4th 2011).

Jordan Spieth — Spieth is on a trend and he finished 19th at Pebble Beach last year, his first time playing at the tourney.

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker is the defending champion, however, his play of late isn't exactly inspiring.

Patrick Reed – Reed finished 19th in his most recent event played, he won the event prior to that, he's on a bit of a roll. Reed finished 7th at Pebble Beach last year, his debut at the event.

Jimmy Walker — Walker finished in the top 10 for 3 consecutive years at this event, from 2011-13.

Graeme McDowell – McDowell has 4 straight top 20 finishes in his last 4 events played. McDowell is on a trend and he won the US Open at Pebble Beach last time it was here (2010).
