Jordan Spieth – Spieth finished in the top 10 at this event last year, he hasn't missed a cut in his last 5 starts and he's finished inside the top 20 in 4 of his 5 most recent events played.

Brendon Todd – Todd has 3 top 10 finishes in his 4 most recent events played, including a win. Todd finished 13th at this event last year.

Jason Day – Day hasn't missed a cut in his 5 most recent events played, which include and win and a 4th place finish. Day has 2 top 10 finishes at this tourney over the past 4 years.

Justin Rose — Rose is on a trend and has 3 top 15 finishes in his 5 most recent events played, Rose also won this event in 2010.

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker has 2 top 10 finishes and a 16th in 3 times played at this event over the past 5 years. He's also finished 11th and 9th in his most recent 2 events played.
