St. Jude picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson finished 10th at St Jude last year and won it in 2012. He finished 46th last week at Memorial, but had a 7th and 14th the 2 events prior.

Lee Westwood — Westwood has 3 top 10 finishes over his 5 most recent events played, including a win. Westwood also won this tourney in 2010.

Ryan Palmer – Palmer is on a trend and he has 2 top 10 finishes over his last 5 events played. Palmer finished 4th here last year and 3rd the year prior.

Harris English — English is the defending champion and he's on a trend coming into the tourney.

John Senden – Senden is another player on a trend with top 30 finishes in 5 consecutive events played. Senden finished 4th at this event in 2009, his best finish in the last 3 times he's played here.

Billy Horschel – Horschel is on a trend as well and finished 10th at St Jude last year.

Paul Casey — Casey has 4 top 20 finishes in his 5 most recent events played, and he's on a 2-event trend.

Luke Guthrie – Guthrie is on a trend, he finished 8th last week and posted a 19th place finish at St Jude in 2012.

Kevin Kisner – Kisner is on a trend with 2 top 20 finishes over the past 5 events played and he finished 13th here in 2012.

J.B. Holmes – Holmes is on a slight trend and he placed 19th at St Jude in 2012.
