WGC Bridgestone picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Adam Scott – Scott has 4 consecutive top 10 finishes coming into this tourney, including a win. Scott also won this event in 2011.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy finished inside the top 10 for 3 consecutive years (2010-12) and he's coming off his 3rd major victory at The Open Championship.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson finished in the top 10 in 4 of his last 5 events played. Stenson finished 2nd at Bridgestone last year.

Jim Furyk — Furyk has 2 consecutive top 10 finishes in his last 2 most recent events played. Furyk also has 3 top 10 finishes at Bridgestone over the past 4 years.

Graeme McDowell – McDowell has 4 top 10 finishes in his 4 most recent events played, including a win. However, his best finish at Bridgestone over the past 5 years is 22nd in 2010.

Keegan Bradley – Bradley has 2 top 10s in his 5 most recent events played. Bradley finished 2nd at Bridgestone last year and he won it the year prior - 2012.

Steve Stricker – Stricker is on a trend and he's 3 top 10s over the past 5 years at this event.

Tiger Woods – Woods is another player on a slight trend. Woods also has 2 wins over the past 5 years at this tourney. Woods is the defending champion.

Martin Kaymer – Kaymer has 3 top 15 finishes in his 5 most recent events played, including a win. Kaymer's best finish at this tourney in the past 5 years is 9th, last year.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia has 2 top 10s in his 3 most recent events played. Garcia's best finish over the past 5 years at Bridgestone is 22nd in 2009 and 2010.
