Zurich Picks 2014

Zurich picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Justin Rose – Rose is on a trend and he's finished inside the top 15 at the Zurich for the past 2 years straight.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler comes into the Zurich with back to back top 10 finishes in his 2 most recent events played. Fowler also finished 10th here in 2012.

Fredrik Jacobson – Jacobson has 5 straight top 20 finishes in his 5 most recent events played. However, Jacobson hasn't played this event in over 5 years.

George McNeill – McNeill, like Jacobson, has 5 consecutive top 20 finishes coming into this event. McNeill finished 6th here in 2011.

Will MacKenzie — MacKenzie posted 3 top 10 finishes in 4 events played prior to missing the cut last week at Harbour Town. Looking for a rebound week here.

Russell Knox – Knox is on a trend with a top 10 finish in his most recent event played. Knox finished 30th at the Zurich in 2012.

Matt Every – Every is also on a trend having finished 12th last week after missing the cut at the Masters the week prior. Every finished 32nd last year at the Zurich.

Cameron Tringale — Tringale was on a trend with a 4th place finish prior to missing the cut at Harbour Town last week. Tringale finished 7th here in 2012.

J.B. Holmes – Holmes has back to back top 20 finishes coming into this event and finished 13th at this event in 2012.

Nick Watney – Watney is somewhat on a trend finishing 44th at the Masters after a withdrawal in his previous start. Watney has 2 top 20 finishes in the last 3 years at the Zurich.
