

Quail Hollow Picks 2015

Quail Hollow picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 4 top 10s in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. McIlroy also has 4 top 10s at this event in the past 5 years, including a win.

Jim Furyk – Furyk has 2 top 10s in his most recent 3 events played, including a win. Furyk has 2 top 10s at this tourney over the past 5 years. Also, Furyk won here in 2006.

J.B. Holmes – Holmes is the defending champion and he has 2 top 10s in his most recent 4 events played, including a win.

Louis Oosthuizen – Oosthuizen was on a trend, including 2 top 10s prior to a 69th finish at the Players last week.

Patrick Reed – Reed has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Reed finished 32nd at Quail Hollow in 2012 and 2013.

Henrik Stenson – The Swede is on a trend and has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. However, his best finish at this event in the past 5 years is 3 missed cuts...

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson was on a trend prior to a missed cut at the Players last week. Mickelson has posted 3 top 10s at Quail Hollow over the past 5 years.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, he hasn't missed a cut in his last 5 events either. Matsuyama finished 38th last year at Quail Hollow, his first go around at this tourney.

Kevin Kisner – Kisner has 2 second place finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including 2nd at the Players last week. Kisner also finished 6th at this event last year.

Bill Haas – Haas is on a trend and he finished 4th last week at the Players. Haas finished 4th at this tourney in 2011.
