Quicken Loans picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Justin Rose – Rose is on a trend and he finished 6th in his most recent event played. Rose is the defending champion and he won this event in 2010 as well.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler finished 30th in his most recent event played (The Open Championship) after winning the prior week. Fowler finished 21st at this tourney in 2013.

Jimmy Walker – Walker is on a trend.

Johnson Wagner – Wagner finished in the top 20 in his 3 most recent events played.

Scott Langley – Langley has not missed a cut in his 5 most recent events played, which includes 4 top 25 finishes.

Will Wilcox – Wilcox has back to back top 10 finishes in his most recent 2 events played.

Andres Romero – Romero has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Romero finished 5th at the Quicken Loans tourney last year.
