

Zurich Picks 2015

Zurich picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 3 top 10s in his 3 most recent events played, including a win.

Justin Rose – Rose is on a trend with a 2nd place finish in his most recent event played (The Masters). Rose also has 3 top 15 finishes at Zurich in the last 3 years.

Jason Day – Day is one of the strongest players in the field and finished outside the top 30 in only one of his most recent 5 events played – Day also posted a win in one of those 5 events.

Harris English – English has 4 top 30 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and English finished 6th at this event the last time he played here in 2013.

Scott Piercy – Piercy is on a trend and he finished 13th at Zurich in 2012.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler is on a trend and he finished 10th at Zurich in 2012..

Brendan Steele – Steele has not missed a cut in his 4 most recent events played and he's posted 3 top 15 finishes in that span.

Morgan Hoffmann – Hoffmann is on a trend and he finished 9th last week at Harbour Town. Hoffmann also finished 21st at this event in 2013.

Bo Van Pelt – Van Pelt is on a trend with a 9th finish last week and he finished 25th at this tourney last year.

Seung-yul Noh – Noh is the defending champion.
