

Bay Hill Picks 2015

Bay Hill picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson comes into Bay Hill with back to back top 5 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Stenson finished 5th at Bay Hill last year and 8th in 2013.

Bubba Watson – Watson finished 3rd in his most recent event played, he has a 2nd and a 10th in 4 events played this year. Watson finished 14th at Bay Hill in 2013 and 4th in 2012.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 10s in 4 events played this year. This is his first go at this event.

J.B. Holmes – Holmes is playing well lately, 3 top 10s in his most recent 4 events played, including 2 seconds. Holmes finished 10th at this event last year.

Kevin Na – Na comes into Bay Hill with back to back top 10s in his last 2 events played. Na finished 14th at this tourney last year, 4th in 2012 and 2nd in 2010.

Brendan Steele – Steele is on a trend with an 11th place finish in his most recent event played (Honda). Steele finished 20th at Bay Hill last year.

Jason Day – Day has 3 top 10s in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. However, Day's best finish at Bay Hill in the past 5 years (2 plays) is 25th in 2010.

Keegan Bradley – Bradley is on a trend and has back to back top 3 finishes at Bay Hill over the past 2 years.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 2 top 10s in his most recent 4 events played. This is his first Bay Hill tourney.

Adam Scott – Scott missed the cut at Valspar last week, doubtful he makes it 2 in a row. Scott finished 4th in his event prior to Valspar and he finished 3rd at Bay Hill last year.
