

Byron Nelson Picks 2015

Byron Nelson picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth could be ready to go on another top 2/winning spree based on his 2nd place finish at Colonial last week. Best finish in 5 years at Nelson is 16th in 2010 when he was still an amateur.

Dustin Johnson – After a couple weeks off and a 69th place finish at the players, he could be rusty, but he also took about 8 months off and came back pretty strong. Johnson finished 7th at this event last year and 7th in 2010.

Marc Leishman – Leishman hasn't missed a cut in his most recent 4 events played which includes 3 top 30s and a top 10 finish. Leishman has 2 top 5 finishes here in the past 3 years played.

Zach Johnson – Johnson has 3 consecutive top 20 finishes in his 4 most recent events played.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar has 2 top 10 finishes at this tourney over the past 4 years. However, Kuchar has only 1 top 10 finish in his most recent 5 events played.

Charley Hoffman – Hoffman is on a trend and he finished 8th at this event in 2013, the most recent year he participated.

Morgan Hoffmann – Hoffmann is on a trend and he finished 16th last year and 5th in 2013.

Ian Poulter – Seems as though Poulter is playing like he might have something to prove, which could propel him to a win. Poulter is on a trend as well.

Gary Woodland – Woodland is on a trend and he finished 4th at Quail Hollow 2 weeks ago. Woodland finished 7th at the Byron Nelson last year.

John Senden – After consecutive top 10 finishes, Senden missed the cut at the Colonial last week, could be a bounce back week for him. Senden also finished 11th at this tourney last year.
