

Canadian Open Picks 2015

Canadian Open picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Jason Day – Day has back to back top 10 finishes coming into this week, including 4th at The Open Championship last week.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar was on a trend before finishing 58th at The Open Championship last week. Kuchar has 3 top 10 finishes at Canadian Open over the past 5 years.

Jim Furyk – Furyk is on a trend with a 30th finish last week. Furyk also has back to back top 10 finishes at Canadian Open over the last 2 years. (Runner up last year)

Bubba Watson – Watson missed the cut last week, potential bounce back week for him – especially if he likes the course and it's not too windy. Watson finished 21st at this event in 2013.

Luke Donald – Donald has 3 top 12 finishes in his 3 most recent starts.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka is on a trend with a 10th place finish at The Open Championship last week. Koepka also has 4 top 25 finishes in his 4 most recent events played.

J.B. Holmes – Holmes was on a trend prior to missing the cut last week. Holmes finished 15th at this tourney in 2012 – his most recent Canadian Open played.

Ryan Palmer – Palmer is on a trend and he hasn't missed a cut in his 5 most recent events played. Palmer also has 2 top 25 finishes at this event over the past 5 years.

Tony Finau – Prior to missing the cut in his most recent event played, Finau posted 4 top 25 finishes in a row. This is his 1st Canadian Open.

Andres Romero – Romero has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Romero finished 3rd at this event in 2011, 21st in '13 and 20th last year.
