

Greenbrier Picks 2015

Greenbrier picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Bubba Watson – Watson won last week; he could win 2 in a row. Watson finished 16th at Greenbrier last year and 30th in 2013.

J.B. Holmes – Holmes is on a trend and he finished 27th at the U.S. Open. Holmes finished 23rd at Greenbrier last year, 27th in 2012 and 16th in 2010.

Bill Haas – Haas was on a trend prior to missing the cut at the U.S. Open. Haas finished 9th at Greenbrier in 2013 and 2nd in 2011.

Louis Oosthuizen – Oosthuizen is always a gamble with his recurring health problems. Oosthuizen finished 2nd at the U.S. Open followed by a cut at Travelers last week. Only start at Greenbrier 17th in 2013.

Patrick Reed – Reed was on a trend prior to missing the cut at Travelers last week. Last year Reed finished 26th at Greenbrier.

Webb Simpson – Simpson is on a trend and he has 3 top 10 finishes at Greenbrier over the past 4 years.

Kevin Kisner – Kisner has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. He hasn't made a cut at Greenbrier; however, he's never been playing this well going into it.

Chris Stroud – Stroud is on a trend with a 10th place finish in his most recent event played. Stroud finished 4th at Greenbrier last year and 9th in 2010 (also, 18th in 2011).

Paul Casey – Casey is on a trend with a playoff last week to Bubba Watson at Travelers. This is Casey's first time at Greenbrier tourney.

Brendon Todd – Todd is on a trend and he finished 15th in his most recent event played. Todd also finished 4th last year at this tourney.
