

Hero World Challenge Picks 2015

Hero World Challenge picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 3 top 10s in his most recent 3 events played, including a win. Spieth is the defending champion, although on a different course.

Patrick Reed – Reed has 5 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Reed finished 3rd at this event last year.

Justin Rose – Rose has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Rose was 6th at this tourney last year.

Adam Scott – Scott is another player with 4 top 10s in his most recent 5 events.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler is on a trend and he has 5 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win. Fowler has 3 top 10 finishes at this tourney in the last 4 years.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Zach Johnson – Johnson has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Johnson also has 4 top 10s and a win at this event over the past 5 years.

Paul Casey – Casey is on a trend to go along with 5 consecutive top 25 finishes in his last 5 events played. Casey finished 3rd at this event in 2010 and 2011.

Bubba Watson – Watson is another player on a trend to go along with 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Watson has 2 top 10s in the last 3 years at this tourney.
