

Honda Picks 2015

Honda picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy won his most recent event played, and finished 2nd in 3 of his most recent 5 events played. McIlroy finished 2nd at Honda last year and he won in 2012.

Justin Rose – Rose finished in the top 15 in 4 of his most recent 5 events played. Rose posted 3 top 5 finishes the last 3 times he played this event (2013, 2012 and 2010).

Dustin Johnson – Johnson finished in the top 5 in his 2 most recent events played. Johnson posted a 46th finish in 2013, his only start at Honda in the last 5 years.

Ryan Palmer – Palmer has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Palmer also finished 2nd at Honda last year.

Lee Westwood – Westwood has 3 consecutive top 10 finishes in his most recent 3 events played coming into this tourney. Westwood also has 3 top 10s at the Honda over the past 5 years.

Keegan Bradley – Bradley is on a trend with a 4th place finish last week at Riviera. Bradley finished 12th at Honda last year, 4th in 2013 and 12th in 2012.

Martin Kaymer – Kaymer finished in the top 4 in his 3 most recent events played.

Sergio Garcia – Garcia is on a trend with a 4th place finish last week at Riviera. Garcia also finished in the top 10 last year at Honda (8th).

Patrick Reed – Reed is another player on a trend, also trending in finishes at Honda over past 2 years.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka has 2 wins in his 5 most recent events played. Koepka finished 33rd at this event last year.
