Memorial Picks 2015

Memorial picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth cooled off a little, but he's still the highest ranked player in the field. Spieth finished 19th at the Memorial last year and he finished 63rd in 2013.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson is on a trend and finished 8th last week. Johnson finished 4th at this event in 2011.

Justin Rose — Rose is on a trend and he has 3 top 10 finishes at this event including a win in 2010.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar is another player on a trend. Kuchar finished 15th at the Memorial last year, to go along with 3 top 10s, including a win in the last 5 years at this tourney.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama is the defending champion. Matsuyama has 4 consecutive top 20 finishes coming into this tournament in his most recent 4 events played.

Jim Furyk — Furyk missed the cut in his most recent event played, Furyk usually does well after missing a cut in his previous outing. Furyk has 3 top 20 finishes in the last 5 years at the Memorial.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka is on a trend with a 16th finish last week.

Billy Horschel – Horschel is on a trend and he's 2 consecutive top 20 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Horschel finished 15th at this event last year.

Russell Henley – Henley is on a trend (3 consecutive events). Henley finished 6th at this tourney in 2013.

Kevin Chappell – Chappell has back to back top 20 finishes in his 2 most recent events played. Chappell finished 2nd at the Memorial in 2013.
