Pebble Beach Picks 2015

Pebble Beach picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Jimmy Walker — Walker has 3 consecutive top 10s in his 3 most recent events played, including a win. Walker is the defending champion, also 4 top 10s in a row at this event.

Ryan Palmer — Palmer has 3 top 10s in his 5 most recent events played, including 2 in his most recent 2 events.

Jason Day – Day is coming off a win last week to go along with 3 other top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Day finished 6th at Pebble Beach in 2013.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, he missed the cut last week, look for a strong rebound. Spieth finished 4th at this event last year.

Patrick Reed – Reed has slipped slightly since his win a few weeks ago, however, Reed finished 13th at Pebble Beach last year and 7th in 2013.

Brandt Snedeker — Snedeker has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Snedeker won this event in 2013.

Hunter Mahan – Mahan finished 6th at Pebble Beach last year, 16th in 2013, 15th in 2012 and 2nd in 2011. Mahan has 4 top 30 finishes in his 5 most recent events played.

Spencer Levin – Levin is on a trend with an 11th place finish last week. Levin has 2 top 10 finishes at Pebble in 2011 and 2012.

Kevin Na – Na is on a trend and he's posted 2 top 5s at Pebble Beach over the past 3 years.

J.B. Holmes – Holmes is on a trend and finished 2^{nd} last week in a playoff with Day. Holmes finished 2^{nd} at Pebble Beach in 2010.
