

## Puerto Rico Picks 2015

Puerto Rico picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

**Peter Uihlein** – Uihlein has 2 top 20 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Uihlein finishes 6<sup>th</sup> at this event in 2013..

**Vaughn Taylor** – Taylor has 5 consecutive top 25 finishes in a row coming into this event. Taylor finished 14<sup>th</sup> at Puerto Rico in 2013.

**Boo Weekley** – Weekley finished 8<sup>th</sup> at this tourney in 2013 and 3<sup>rd</sup> in 2012. Weekley also has 2 top 10 finishes in his 5 most recent events played.

**Alvaro Quiros** – Quiros has consecutive top 20 finishes in his most recent 2 events played.

**Daniel Chopra** – Chopra is on a trend with an 11<sup>th</sup> place finish in his most recent event played.

**Jonathan Byrd** – Byrd finished 12<sup>th</sup> at this event last year and he's on a slight trend.

**Will MacKenzie** – MacKenzie was on a trend prior to a missed cut in his most recent event played. MacKenzie finished 32<sup>nd</sup> at Puerto Rico in 2012.

**Jeff Overton** – Overton is on a trend with a 7<sup>th</sup> place finish in his most recent event played. The past 2 times Overton played this event he finished 14<sup>th</sup> in 2012 and 15<sup>th</sup> in 2010.

**David Toms** – Toms has 2 top 25 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he finished 4<sup>th</sup> at this tourney last year.

**Brendon de Jonge** – de Jonge is on a trend coming into this event and he's posted 3 top 15 finishes at Puerto Rico over the past 4 years he's played the tourney, including a 3<sup>rd</sup> in 2010.
