RSM picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Zach Johnson – Johnson is on a slight trend with an 8th place finish in his most recent event played. Johnson finished 12th at this event in 2010 and 16th in 2013.

Matt Kuchar — Kuchar has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Kuchar has 4 top 25 finishes at this tourney over the past 5 years.

Patrick Rodgers — Rodgers has 4 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played, including 2 top 10s. Rodgers is also trending.

Justin Thomas — Thomas has 2 top 3 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win. Thomas finished 71st at RSM last year.

Kevin Kisner – Kisner is on a trend with a 2^{nd} place finish in his most recent event played. Kisner finished 4^{th} at RSM last year and 20^{th} in 2013.
