

Sony Picks 2015

Sony picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Jimmy Walker – Walker lost in a playoff last week at the Hyundai and he is the defending champion at Sony.

Jason Day – Day has 4 top 10 finishes in his 5 most recent events played.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar finished 17th last week at Hyundai in a small 30ish player field. However, Kuchar has 3 top 10s in his last 3 Sony events played, last year, 2013 and 2011.

Zach Johnson – Johnson has back to back top 10 finishes coming into this event and he finished 8th last year.

Chris Kirk – Kirk has 3 top 20 finishes in his 3 most recent events played, 14th at Hyundai, with a final round 62, 11 under. Kirk finished 2nd at the Sony last year and 5th in 2013..

Marc Leishman – Leishman has back to back top 15 finishes in his 2 most recent events played and he's finished inside the top 10 at the Sony in the last 2 years.

Charles Howell III – Howell was on a trend prior to a missed cut in his most recent event. However, the cut is offset by his top 10 finishes in 4 of the last 5 years at the Sony (3 top 5s).

Russell Henley – Henley finished 3rd at the Hyundai last week and he won the Sony in 2013.

Ryan Palmer – Palmer has 3 top 10 finishes in his 5 most recent events played. Palmer is a Sony winner, in 2010, and he finished 8th at this event last year.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama is on a slight trend, he finished 3rd last week at the Hyundai, 13th the event prior, however, he won the event before that. However, Matsuyama hasn't made a cut in his 3 Sony appearances.
