Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 3 top 20s in his most recent 4 events played. Johnson won this event in 2012 and he finished 10th in 2013.

Harris English – English is on a trend and he won this event in 2013.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka was on a trend prior to last week's 52nd place finish. Koepka finished 19th at St. Jude's last year, his first go around at the tourney.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson finished 11th at this event last year and 2nd in 2013. Mickelson is also on a slight trend.

Billy Horschel – Horschel is on a trend and he's had 3 consecutive top 20 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. Horschel finished 6th at this event last year and 10th in 2013.
