

Tour Championship Picks 2015

Tour Championship picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Jason Day – Day has 3 wins in his most recent 4 events played. Day finished 4th last year at the Tour Championship.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy is on a trend and he finished 4th last week at the BMW. McIlroy finished 2nd at the Tour Championship last year.

Justin Rose – Rose is on a trend and he has 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Rose finished in the top 10 at the Tour Championship for the past 3 years in a row.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Stenson won this event in 2013.

Bubba Watson – Watson is on a trend and he finished 10th last week at the BMW. Watson has 2 top 15 finishes at the Tour Championship over the past 3 years.

Rickie Fowler – Fowler has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including a win at the Deutsche Bank. Fowler finished 8th at this tourney last year.

Zach Johnson – Johnson is on a trend and he finished 7th at this event in 2013.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson is on a trend and he has 2 top 10 finishes at the Tour Championship over the past 3 years.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth is on a trend with a 13th place finish last week. Spieth finished 2nd at this event in 2013.

J.B. Holmes – Holmes is on a trend with a 4th place finish last week at the BMW.
