

U.S. Open Picks 2015

U.S. Open picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy is the number one ranked player in the world. He missed 2 consecutive cuts in his most recent 2 events played. But, who cares, he's still good.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 2 top 15 finishes in his most recent 3 events played. He's 2 top 10s at the U.S. Open over the past 5 years.

Justin Rose – Rose is on a trend and finished 2nd in his most recent event played. Rose also won this tournament in 2013, he finished 12th last year.

Brandt Snedeker – Snedeker has back to back top 10 finishes coming into this event and he's 3 top 15 finishes at the U.S. Open over the past 5 years.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth is on a trend, he finished 3rd in his most recent event played and he finished 17th at this tourney last year.

Henrik Stenson – Stenson is on a trend and he finished 4th last year at the U.S. Open.

Martin Kaymer – Kaymer is the defending champion.

Phil Mickelson – Mickelson is on a trend and he has 2 top 10s at the U.S. Open over the past 5 years.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has 3 top 10s in his most recent 5 events played (the other 2, top 20s). Matsuyama finished 35th last year at the U.S. Open and 10th in 2013.

Ian Poulter – Poulter is on a trend and he finished 17th at the U.S. Open last year.
