Valero picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson won his most recent event played and he's 2 other top 4 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Jordan Spieth – Spieth also won his most recent event played and he has 2 other top 10 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Spieth finished 10th at this event last year.

Matt Kuchar — Kuchar has 2 top 3 finishes in his most recent 5 events played and he's back to back top 15s at this tourney.

Charley Hoffman – Hoffman has 2 top 3 finishes at Valero in the past 4 years and he has not finished outside the top 13 in the past 5 years at this event.

Martin Kaymer — Kaymer is on a trend with a 31 finish in his most recent event played. However, Kaymer has 3 top 5 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Jimmy Walker – Walker is another player on a trend. Walker also has a win in his most recent 5 events played and he finished 16th at this tourney last year.

Jim Furyk — Furyk finished 6th at Valero last year and 3rd in 2013. Furyk has a couple top 15 finishes in his most recent 4 events played this year and 1 top 10.

Kevin Na – Na is on a trend with a 6th place finish at Bay Hill last week – which gives him 3 consecutive top 10 finishes. Na finished 11th last year at Valero.

Daniel Summerhays – Summerhays was on a trend until last week when he finished 55th. He could bounce back this week especially considering he finished 2nd at this tourney last year and 7th in 2013.

Zach Johnson – Johnson is on a trend with a 9^{th} place finish at Bay Hill last week. Johnson finished 6^{th} at Valero last year.
