

Barclays picks 2016

Barclays picks are based on recent performance and historical performance at the event. Picks can be verified by checking out the statistics page on the web site. Others to consider are based on other various factors, stats, trends, etc. Note – Barclays event at Bethpage was 2012.

Dustin Johnson – Johnson has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins. Johnson has 3 top 10s at Barclays in the last 5 years, was 3rd in 2012 (at Bethpage).

Henrik Stenson – Stenson has 4 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played, including 2 wins. Stenson finished 2nd at Barclays last year, 54th in 2012.

Jason Day – Day has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Day won this event last year, he was 24th at Bethpage in 2012.

Jim Furyk – Furyk has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Furyk finished in the top 10 at Barclays in 2 of the last 3 years.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. McIlroy finished 24th at Barclays in 2012.

Brooks Koepka – Koepka has 3 top 10 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Justin Rose – Rose has 3 top 22 finishes in his most recent 3 events played, including a win. Rose also has 2 top 10s at Barclays in the last 5 years (46th in 2012).

Adam Scott – Scott is on a trend coming into this event to go along with 3 top 20 finishes in his most recent 4 events played. Scott won the Barclays in 2013.

Hideki Matsuyama – Matsuyama has back to back top 5 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Matsuyama finished 13th at Barclays last year.

Patrick Reed – Reed has 4 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played. Reed finished 9th at Barclays in 2014.
