Adam Scott – Scott has back to back wins coming into this tourney, could he make it 3? Why not? Scott finished 3rd at Bay Hill in 2014.

Rory McIlroy – McIlroy has 3 top 10s in his most recent 5 events played and he's on a trend coming into this event. McIlroy finished 11th at this tourney last year.

Sunghoon Kang – Kang has 4 top 25 finishes in his most recent 4 events played.

Matt Kuchar – Kuchar is trending coming into this tourney and he has 3 top 15 finishes in his most recent 5 events played.

Scott Brown – Brown is on a trend to go along with his 2 top 10 finishes in his most recent 2 events played. Brown finished 13th at Bay Hill in 2013.
